



Lutz Güllner works in the European Commission's Directorate General for Trade, where he is Deputy Head of the Unit for Information, Communication and Civil Society. In his work, he particularly focusses on communication activities regarding the EU-US trade negotiations. Prior to his current position he served as Deputy Head of the Trade Strategy Unit. He was also responsible for the coordination of EU-US trade and economic relations, including the Transatlantic Economic Council.

In 2009 and 2010, Lutz Güllner was spokesperson for the High Representative of the European Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy, Catherine Ashton. He was also the Commission's spokesperson for trade policy. For a number of years, he coordinated trade and economic relations between the EU and Russia.

Prior to joining the European Commission, Lutz Güllner worked as public affairs consultant in Brussels.

Lutz Güllner studied political science and international relations at the Free University of Berlin and the Institut d'Etudes Politiques (Sciences Po) in Paris. He is teaching trade policy and EU foreign affairs at the post-graduate studies programme for European studies in Berlin.
